

SPACE WOLVES RHINO

The Rhino armoured personnel carrier has swiftly and sturdily carried Space Wolves Space Marines into battle in countless wars on countless worlds for millennia. Able to carry up to ten fully equipped Space Wolves into battle, the Rhino's job is to get its payload of troops as close to the enemy as quickly as possible and unload them into the heart of the fight, where

the Space Wolves love to be. Armed with a Storm Bolter for deadly close-range support fire, it is armoured with reinforced ceramite to provide great protection to the infantry inside. The Rhino is a highly manoeuvrable and reliable vehicle, able to navigate many types of terrain and the Space Wolves believe that a vehicle that can handle the harsh terrain of Fenris is worthy of respect.

SPACE WOLVES RAZORBACK

A combination of armoured personnel carrier and mobile support weapon platform, the Razorback is used extensively by the Space Wolves Grey Hunters and is a particular favourite of their veteran Long Fang packs, who often utilise the vehicle's extra firepower to make up for the losses of man-power that accrue within a pack over the years. Replacing part of

the troop compartment of a Rhino personnel carrier with that of a twin-linked weapon system mounted atop the vehicle's hull, the Razorback is able to lay down a large amount of firepower in support of an attack and deliver its passengers safely into position. Space Wolves make use of Razorbacks versatility and it's common for the interiors to double as medical bays, or heavy weapon storage for Long Fangs.

LAND SPEEDER

Used by virtually all Chapters of the Adeptus Astartes, the Space Wolves employ their Land Speeders in a different role to those of their Codex brothers. Where a Codex Chapter's Land Speeders are utilised in a forward reconnaissance role, the Wolf Lords prefer to leave that duty to their Wolf Scouts so, instead, throw theirs into a

direct attack role. Manned by two Grey Hunters and borne aloft by anti-gravitic repulsor plates on it's underside, the Land Speeder is a lightly armoured, but highly agile attack craft. The Grey Hunter crew revel in the sheer daring of these types of attacks and will regularly execute highly complex combat manoeuvres whilst doing so.
